Nathaniel had one particular conversation that shows the Holy Spirit's willingness to show up on the beaches outside Tampa Florida:

We approached Victor and Diana while they were sunbathing. Instead of being annoyed by our interruption, these young college students perked up when we asked them to share their throughs and experiences on life and faith. They came from a religiously hypocritical background where faith was enforced, but the fruit of genuine Christ-like love was foreign. In spite of that upbringing, both were curious about the things of God, but worried that if they became "religious," they'd turn into their parents.

After answering all our questions, we asked if they'd be interested to hear how we find our faith has produced something far different than what they'd experienced. With great curiosity, they listened. You could see the veil of blindness being partially lifted as we explained who Jesus is and what a relationship with Him truly looks like. My sharing buddy, Minna, shared how her relationship with Jesus is a comfort, but also as a source of liberating her to love those around her rather than perform for or control others. In the end, though they were inspired to see God, Jesus, church and the Bible differently, they expressed some hesitancy to follow Jesus from some residual doubt from their upbringing. I'm pretty confident the next time someone offers them a chance to follow Jesus, the Holy Spirit will have led them to be ready to make that decision. You could see He was truly working!
